We appreciate the Department's invitation for Ranking Member Meeks and me to review the Dissent Channel cable and response with the names of the signatories redacted. The Department's letter offers to make these documents available to view at the State Department "at your convenience." I am available to view the documents as soon as possible.

In light of this invitation, I will pause efforts to enforce the Committee's subpoena pending my review of the documents. Please note, however, that the subpoena remains in full force and effect, and the acceptance of this accommodation does not waive any of the Committee's rights regarding the subpoena.
