

Gregory Kausner joined Anduril Industries as the SVP, Global Defense in 2022. Previously, he held leadership roles in the Department of Defense, Department of State, on Capitol Hill, and served in the U.S. Navy as an aviator.

At the Department of Defense, Greg performed the duties of Under and Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment, served as Executive Director for International Cooperation in the Office of the Secretary of Defense, and was the Deputy Director of the Defense Security Cooperation Agency. At State, he was a Senior Advisor to the Under Secretary for Arms Control and International Security and the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Political Military Affairs. In the Senate, Greg served as a Senior Professional Staff Member on the Foreign Relations Committee.

As a Naval Officer, he piloted F-14s and F/A-18s, represented the Navy to Congress as a Senate Liaison, mobilized as the Deputy Director of the Naval and Amphibious Liaison Element, and conducted Reserve assignments to the Defense Innovation Unit, the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations, and the Office of Naval Intelligence.

Greg is the recipient of the Defense Medal for Exceptional Civilian Service, the Defense Medal for Meritorious Civilian Service, the Secretary of State's Award for Excellence in International Security Affairs, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Air Medal-Individual Action (with Combat V), and the Air Medal (Strike Flight).
