Supporting Israel and Countering Iran in the 118th Congress

Iran-backed Hamas' brutal October 7 attack on Israel killed over 1,200 innocent people, including Americans, and Iran has continued its nuclear program, support for terrorist proxies, and other malign activities. The House Foreign Affairs Committee has worked tirelessly on bipartisan bills to support Israel and counter Iran.

ENACTED INTO LAW IN THE 21st CENTURY PEACE THROUGH STRENGTH ACT:

H.R. 3152, Fight and Combat Rampant Iranian Missile Exports Act (Chairman McCaul)

Imposes sanctions on anyone involved in the supply, sale, transfer of, or support for Iran's drone and missile program.

H.R. 589, MAHSA Act (Rep. Banks)

A Requires full enforcement of human rights sanctions on the Iranian regime.

H.R. 340, Hamas International Financing Prevention Act (Rep. Mast)

▲ Sanctions Hamas, Palestinian Islamic Jihad, Al-Aqsa Martyr's Brigade, the Lion's Den, and other Palestinian terrorist groups and their supporters.

H.R. 3774, SHIP Act (Rep. Lawler)

A Requires sanctions on ports and refineries that receive and process Iranian oil.

H.R. 5917, Strengthening Tools to Counter the Use of Human Shields Act (Rep. Gallagher)

▲ Strengthens and reauthorizes the 2018 Sanctioning the Use of Civilians as Defenseless Shields Act.

H.R. 6603, No Technology for Terror Act (Rep. Moran, Chairman McCaul)

▲ Further restricts the export or re-export of U.S.-origin goods and technology to Iran, including those used to manufacture missiles and drones.

HOUSE PASSED & AWAITING SENATE ACTION:

H.R. 3033, Solidify Iran Sanctions Act (Rep. Steel)

A Repeals the sunset provision in the 1996 Iran Sanctions Act.

H.R. 8369, Israel Security Assistance Support Act (Rep. Calvert)

▲ Takes sweeping action to require the Administration to deliver defense articles and services to Israel promptly.

H.R. 8282, the Illegitimate Court Counteraction Act (Rep. Roy)

▲ Sanctions any foreign person engaged in or aiding an ICC case against an American citizen or citizen of a partner country not party to the ICC.

H.R. 6046, the Standing Against Houthi Aggression Act (Rep. Clyde)

A Re-lists the Houthis as a Foreign Terrorist Organization after the Biden administration de-listed the group in 2021.

H.R. 5961, No Funds for Iranian Terrorism Act (Chairman McCaul)

A Prevents Iran from accessing the \$6 billion in Iranian funds held in Qatar by imposing sanctions on any bank that transacts with this money, and prohibits the President from using sanctions waivers. An amendment by Rep. Pfluger permanently freezes \$10 billion in sanctioned Iranian assets in Iraq, without exception.

H.R. 4691, Iran Sanctions Relief Review Act (Rep. Self)

▲ Gives Congress the opportunity to review and disapprove of any Iran sanctions relief proposal from the President, including for a nuclear deal.

H.R. 5826, No Paydays for Hostage-Takers Act (Rep. Wilson)

▲ Deters the Government of Iran, and others, from taking U.S. hostages by imposing sanctions and strict penalties.
